- The Denver Campus for Jewish Education comprises a nondenominational K–5 Jewish Day School, and a Jewish academic 6–12 high school. It has a beautiful new 18-acre campus and updated facilities.

The Speer Parkway and Colfax Avenue provide convenient 15-minute access to the Yeshiva Toras Chaim and Beth Jacob High School for Girls on the West Side of Denver. BMH/BJ and the Jewish Community Center support preschools for children ages two through five.
