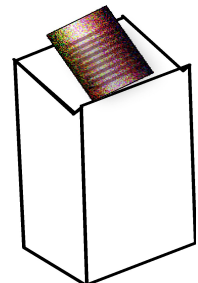

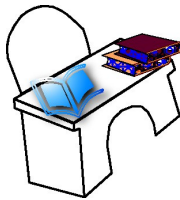

From The Rabbi's Desk

הלכות תפילה סימן ספר הרוקח, שכב, comments that tradition of taking three steps forward before beginning the שמונה עשרה is based on the fact that the word ויגש - and he approached - is used three times in connection with prayer.

First, when אברהם pleads for סדום, second, at the beginning of our פרשה and third, when אליהו beseeches Hashem at הר הכרמל. Of the three cases, it is most difficult to understand our case since in the other cases, someone is addressing Hashem, while in this week's פרשה it is יהודה addressing יוסף. In what sense is the considered a prayer?

Rav Yissochar Frand suggests that in fact, יהודה understood that it was hopeless to plead with יוסף. It looked like בנימין was caught red-handed and all of יהודה arguments had been offered previously.



Therefore, even though he was addressing יוסף, in truth his words were directed towards Hashem as he begged for mercy.

Life is challenging and we are required to do what we can to overcome life's challenges. As we do our part and attempt to turn situations in our favor, it is helpful to remember that all of our attempts are, on a certain level, a prayer to Hashem to intercede on our behalf. Hashem orchestrates our experiences through natural means but we must always remember that it is only He that is in control.
