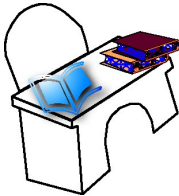

From The Rabbi's Desk

When יעקב, on his death bed, addresses יוסף he tells him הַנּוֹלָדִים בְּנֵי בְנֵיךָ שְׂנֵי בְנֵיךָ וְעַתָּה שְׂנֵי בְנֵי בְנֵיךָ הַנּוֹלָדִים לִי לְךָ בְּאֶרֶץ מִצְרַיִם עַד בָּאִי אֶלֶיךָ מִצְרַיִם לִי - הֵם אֶפְרַיִם וּמְנַשֶּׁה כְּרֵאוּבֵן וְשִׁמְעוֹן יִהְיוּ לִי - And now your two sons, who were born to you in the land of Egypt before I came to you into Egypt, are mine; Ephraim and Manasheh, even as Reuven and Shimon, shall be mine. It is not clear what יעקב is trying to say. One could suggest that יעקב comments that he loves these grandchildren as much as his actual children. Rashi suggests that יעקב is announcing that he is granting a gift to אפרים and מנשה in that they would be treated as individual tribes.



Rav Moshe Feinstein offers a very original idea. Being that יעקב had not met his grandsons until he came down to Egypt, it would seem logical that he could not take credit for how they turned out. However, יעקב is stating here that he takes full responsibility for his grandchildren since through his influence on יוסף, it was inevitable that they would be raised in his path. This was the case even though they lived far away and had never even met him!

We work hard to teach our children and to guide them follow in our ways. This is not always an easy task. The true measure of our success is what happens when they become independent adults, when they can make their own life decisions and we are no longer there to constantly guide them. True success is being able to say with confidence that our children are so committed to our tradition that they raise their children just as we did ours.
