### Condolences

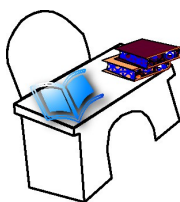

### From The Rabbi's Desk

This week's פרשה begins with the statement וַיִּשְׁמַע יִתְרוֹ . . . כִּי הוֹצִיָּא ה' אֶת יִשְׂרָאֵל מִמִּצְרַיִם - And Yitro heard . . . that Hashem took Israel out of Egypt. It would seem that these words of introduction come to tell us that learning about the great miracles of Hashem led יתרו to leave his home, move to the desert and join the nation of Israel. This seems strange in light of the fact that it was not יתרו alone who heard about these miracles. The happenings in Egypt were international news, as stated in last week's פְּרָשָׁה - שָׁמְעוּ עַמִּים יְהוּדִים וְכָל הָעַמִּים הַשְּׂבִיבוֹת - The nations have heard, they tremble. If יתרו heard the same news as everyone else, why did he have such a different reaction?

Rashi comments several times that the word שמע can have two distinct meanings. Sometimes it means to hear, but other times it means to understand. When the word was used to describe the nations, it merely meant that they heard the news. יתרו, on the other hand, internalized the message and understood that this was the hand of Hashem. This realization made him change his life.

We all listen to the news from Israel and around the world with an open mind, hoping to expand our understanding of the world. The lesson of יתרו is to not only have an open mind but also an open heart so that we can appreciate the hand of Hashem in this world.
