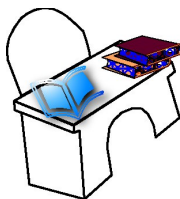

From The Rabbi's Desk

This week's Torah reading focuses on the actual building of the משכן and the related vessels and garments. While listing off what was donated, the פסוק comments וְהַנְּשָׂאִים הֵבִיאוּ אֶת אֲבְנֵי הַשֹּׁהַם וְהַנְּשָׂאִים הֵבִיאוּ אֶת אֲבְנֵי הַמְּלֵאִים לְאַפֹּדוֹ וְלַחֹשֶׁן - וְאֵת אֲבְנֵי הַמְּלֵאִים לְאַפֹּדוֹ וְלַחֹשֶׁן. And the leaders brought the onyx stones, and the stones to be set, for the ephod, and for the breastplate. Rashi notes that the word "וְהַנְּשָׂאִים" is missing a letter to indicate that the leaders were lacking in that they did not pledge to the משכן but rather agreed to donate whatever would be missing at the end. However, one has to wonder if this is truly a fair criticism of the leaders. Wasn't their offer to guarantee that nothing would be missing actually a very generous gift?

Rabbi Josh Hoffman suggests that everyone was encouraged to seek out their own special talents and



use those talents towards the building of the משכן. The נְשִׂאִים failed by ignoring their individual talents and offering to do "whatever was left". Rabbi Hoffman quotes his teacher, Rav Aharon Soloveitchik who explained that this is why the letter "yud" was specifically omitted, as that is the letter that makes something yours (e.g. בְּגָדִי - בְּגָד - clothes become my clothes.)

We are all different and we are all special in some way with specific talents. We need to seek out and utilize those talents to make the world a better place.
