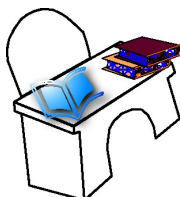

#### From The Rabbi's Desk

The **יקר כלי יקר** comments on the **פסוק** early in **ויקרא** - **אדם כי יקריב** - that every person must give a part of themselves when they bring a sacrifice. This is seen by the use of the word **אדם** which indicates that we are supposed to be like **אדם הראשון** who decided to bring a sacrifice on his own, through his own creativity without being commanded to do so. So too, everyone should use their own creativity to serve Hashem in a personal way.

Based on this, it is difficult to understand why **נדב** **ואביו**, the sons of **אהרן**, were struck down for bring an **אש זרה**, a foreign fire not commanded by Hashem. Shouldn't their attempt at introducing a new form of worship of Hashem be lauded? Rabbi Tuvia Stern suggests that while creativity is encouraged in **עבודת** **השם**, it is only encouraged when it is within the rubric of the laws set down by Hashem. That is represented by the **אש תמיד**, the constant heavenly fire which resides on the alter. The foreign fire which they offered, even if it was offered for positive reasons, was rejected because it violated Torah law.

Many people feel that they can better serve Hashem in their own way. These actions should be encouraged if they do not violate or come at the expense of Hashem's commandments. If the new approach encroaches on any of the actual commandments, it



must be rejected.
