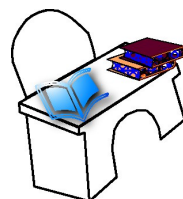

From The Rabbi's Desk

When the spies returned from touring the land of Israel, as we all know, they delivered a negative report which indicated that the land of Israel would be impossible to conquer and thereby discouraged בני ישראל from following Moshe's lead into Israel. While the report begins with major facts - the set up of

the cities, neighboring nations - it drifts into specifics, as it says וַשֵׁם רָאִינוּ אֶת הַנְּפִלִים בְּנֵי עֲנָק מִן הַנְּפִלִים וְנָהִי עִם בְּעֵינֵיהֶם - And there we saw the Nephilim, the sons of Anak, who come of the Nephilim; and we were in our own eyes as grasshoppers, and so we were in their eyes. Rav Moshe Yitzchak Shulman asks, as it seems that there was no conversation between the spies and the giants, how did the spies know how the giants perceived them? (See Rashi 13:43).

Rav Shulman answers that the spies were projecting. They felt small in their own eyes and therefore they assumed that others perceived them that way as well. It was this lack of self esteem that led them to assume that they were being looked down upon and that they had no chance of emerging victorious.

Haughtiness is negative trait that we try to eliminate from our personalities. However, the opposite extreme should be avoided as well. We should have confidence that the combination of hard work, natural ability and help of Hashem will allow us to accomplish our obligations and achieve our life goals.

We are likely to keep the Thursday parasha shiur, the Shabbat Pirkei Avot shiur, medical ethics, practical aspects of modern celebrations and commemorations such as Yom Haatzmaut, Yom Yerushalayim, and Yom HaShoah, Shabbat observance in the kitchen, and post-Shacharit learning several days per week.
