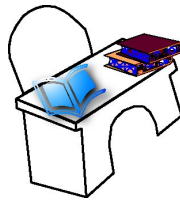

From The Rabbi's Desk

This week's פרשה focuses almost exclusively on Bilam's attempts to curse the Jewish people and his repeated failures which come in the form of blessings to the Jewish people. Of these blessings, the most famous are the words **מֵה טָבוּ אֲהַלֵיךְ יַעֲקֹב** in which Bilam praises the tents of the Jewish people. Rashi, based on the Talmud (**בבא בתרא דף טו עמוד א**), comments that this was a complement, referring to the modest way that the Jewish residences were arranged. However the Talmud elsewhere (**סנהדרין דף קה עמוד ב**) comments that the blessings of **בלעם** were the exact opposite of what he had intended to curse, and in this case he meant to curse that there should be no synagogues or study halls. How is a blessing about the modesty of the Jewish home the opposite of what he had intended?



Rav Moshe Feinstein suggests that the curse was that people should think that because they have such positive home life, there is no need for schools and synagogues. Just as the effectiveness of strong schools will be limited without a supportive home environment, so too, solid homes are not enough

without schools and community.

We must never underestimate the importance of our community institutions and the imperative to give them our full support. **בלעם** himself understood that no matter how strong the individuals are, without our key communal institutions we cannot thrive as individuals and as a nation.
