As in previous years, we hope to capture most of our shiurim on audio. The most recent recording will be on the web home page, and the full list will be found on our [Shiurim page](#).

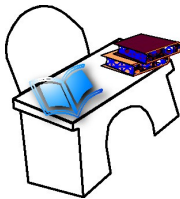

From The Rabbi's Desk

Included in this week's פרשה is Hashem's announcement that יהושע will take over the mantle of leadership from משה. In order to accomplish this, משה is told וסמכת את ידך עליו and you shall lean your hands on him. This is the origin on what we call "סמיכה" where a person is appointed as a rabbi by having a teacher lay his hands on the head of the student and pronouncing the student worthy. Why is the laying of the hands necessary?



Rav Moshe Feinstein suggests that the laying of the hands by the teacher above the student conveys the message that no matter how great the student becomes, his teachers will always be above him. While the student has reached the level where he can

now lead, he must do so with the awareness that he must always honor and respect those who brought him to this point.

This message is not limited to rabbis. Our accomplishments, both as individuals and as a community, are something that we should take pride in. However, we must never forget those who brought us to this point. By giving due respect to our predecessors we will maintain a vision of the tradition we strive to perpetuate, hopefully resulting in the success of our endeavors.
