**Community Lunch**—Today is our Community Lunch celebrating our summer of learning! Thanks to all who helped organize, prepare, and provided other help with the lunch!

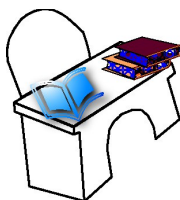
**Friday Mincha Times**—This week is the last week of our summer early Shabbat times. Beginning **next** week, Friday night Mincha moves back to sunset.

### From The Rabbi's Desk

This week's פרשה begins with the words - ראה אנכי נתן לפניכם היום ברכה וקללה - Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse. The אבן עזרא is troubled by the fact that the first word - ראה - is singular, while the continuation of לפניכם is plural. Rav Yosef Kahanman, the late Rosh Yeshiva of the Ponevezh Yeshiva, offers a deep insight based on this. Every person's life includes blessings and curses. However, very few individuals have the sensitivity to realize the daily blessings that we all receive and not take them for granted. Similarly, while everyone experiences hardships, few understand that this is a message from



Hashem urging us to better our ways.

This idea is also expressed in an explanation of an enigmatic פסוק (ספר שמואל (ש"א ט - ט - פסוק) which states - לנביא היום יקרא לפנים הראה - that which we now call a "Navi" used to be called a "Roeh". Why the need to inform us that they changed the word used to describe a prophet? Rav Shlomo Goren explained that the word "לפנים" does not refer to an earlier time in history but rather refers to the prophet himself. The person who is now a prophet started out as a seer - one who paid attention and saw the hand of Hashem. Life provides us all with ups and downs. Our job is to see the hand of Hashem in everything that comes our way, to appreciate the good and learn from the bad. If we take this approach we will put ourselves on the path towards greatness.
