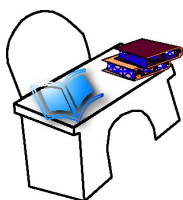

#### From The Rabbi's Desk

It is difficult to understand לוט. When we first meet him, he is Avram and Sarai's closest relative and student, having been raised by them after he was orphaned when his father gave up his life rather than support idol worship. (See רש"י



בראשית פרק יא (כח)). However, as time goes on, he drifts away from Avram and eventually ends up living in Sodom among the most wicked people known to mankind. How do we explain this colossal fall?

Rav Shimon Schwab suggests that it can be traced to one, difficult verse. When לוט is captured during the war of the four kings versus the five kings, the verse states (בראשית פרק יד פסוק יב) וַיִּקְחוּ אֶת לוֹט וְאֶת רְבִישׁוֹ בֶּן אֶחָיו אֲבִרָם וַיֵּלְכוּ - And they took Lot, and his goods, Avram's brother's son, and departed, who dwelt in Sodom. The פסוק seems to be out of order. Why are Lot's possessions mentioned in between his name and his relationship to אברם? Rav Schwab answers that the order of the wording is the key. לוט placed his material possessions ahead of his relationship with אברם and that led to his great spiritual downfall.

We pray for material wealth and see it as a blessing. However, we must remember that this blessing comes with a tremendous challenge. If

pursuit of money and spending become the focus of one's life, far from being a blessing, it can be one's worst enemy.
