Also, beginning next week, Shabbat, until the end of the calendar year, the latest time for kriyat shema occurs before we are likely to reach it in davening.

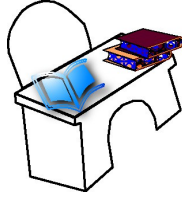
### Youth Activities

### From The Rabbi's Desk

The תורה introduces the episode of עקידת יצחק with the words וַיְהִי אַחֲרֵי הַדְּבָרִים יְצַחַק - הָאֵלֶּה - And it came to pass after these things. The commentaries struggle to understand the connection between this test of אברהם and that which preceded it. The Rashbam suggests that Hashem is upset with Avraham's decision to make a treaty with אבימלך and that leads Him to challenge אברהם. Rashi suggests that this test is in response to the party which אברהם made to celebrate the birth of יצחק during which Avraham graciously served his guests but did not offer a sacrifice to Hashem.



The מדרש focuses on something else that was lacking in Avraham's celebration. The party is referred to as a גדול, משתה גדול, a "great party." The מדרש understands that this refers to the fact the great leaders of the generation were invited. This alludes to Avraham's error, in that he should have invited the needy, rather than limiting his guest list to the rich and famous. Our community prides itself, rightfully so, on its famous Western hospitality. Guests are wined, dined and treated as if they were in a five star restaurant. While it is wonderful for us to enjoy each other's company and thereby enhance our שבת experience, we should first and foremost consider those that really could use an invitation and commit to making sure that no one has to eat a שבת meal alone.
