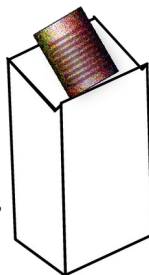

Walk To Free the Hostages—Sunday morning, 10 AM at Washington Park. StandWithUs and others are co-hosting. The event meets at Washington Park every Sunday at 10 AM to walk around the lake until all are freed. Meeting place

is at Mississippi Avenue, at the entrance to park. Run For Their Lives is a global initiative with over 200 groups around the world, to raise awareness for the immediate release of the hostages still being held in Gaza by the terrorist organization Hamas. Most of the hostages are civilians, including 14 women, 9 elderly over the age of 65, and 2 children.
